Bible Story

My First Study Bible, pp. 310–16, "Jesus Is Born"

Story Application:

- The angels told Mary she would have a baby, and the angels told the shepherds that Jesus was born. God uses angels in the Bible to share important messages from God.
- Jesus' birth was very important. God used His angels to tell people Jesus was here. Today we are going to make our own angels. They aren't real angels, but when we look at them, they will remind us of God's special helpers.



Craft

Before class, cut paper plates into angel shapes using the craft page template. Tape pipe cleaner to the back of the plate and twist into a halo. Have children glue hair and body on angel. Have children color angel's face.
