## Bible Story

*My First Study Bible*, pp. 127–33, "I Heard Voices in the Night"

### Story Application:

- Samuel heard God talking just as you hear me talking right now. Most people do not hear God so clearly. God talks to us in other ways too! Even though we may not hear God talking, He hears us when we talk to Him. What do we call that? (Prayer!)
  - Today we are going to make a pretend telephone. This phone is to remind us of some of the ways we can talk to God. We are going to put 3 buttons on our phone. The buttons say: Bible, church, and prayer. These are 3 different ways we can talk to God and He can talk back to us.

## Craft

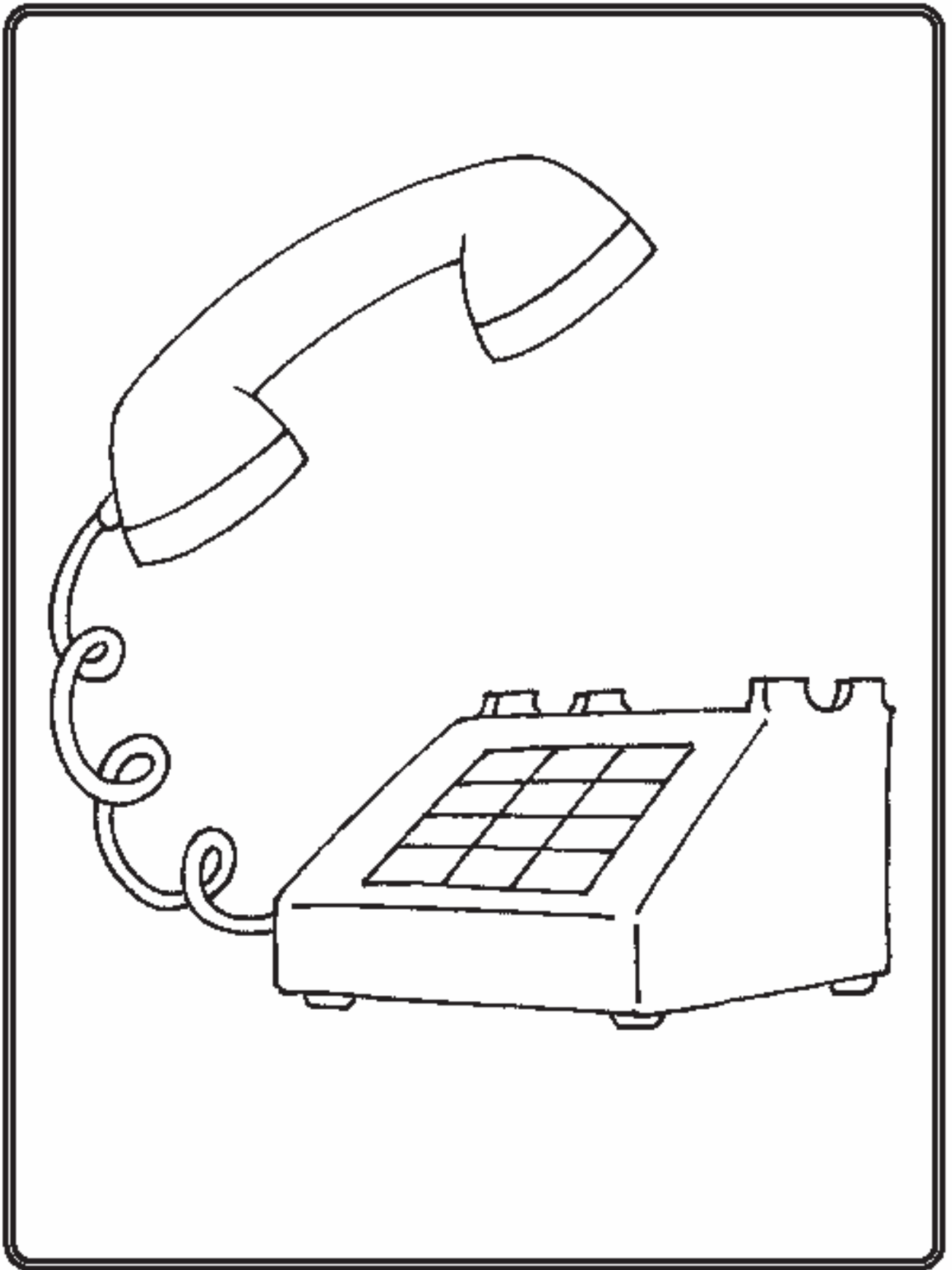

attending church.

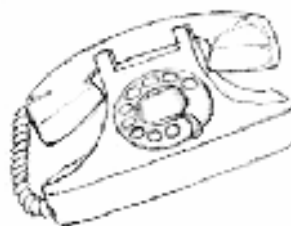
