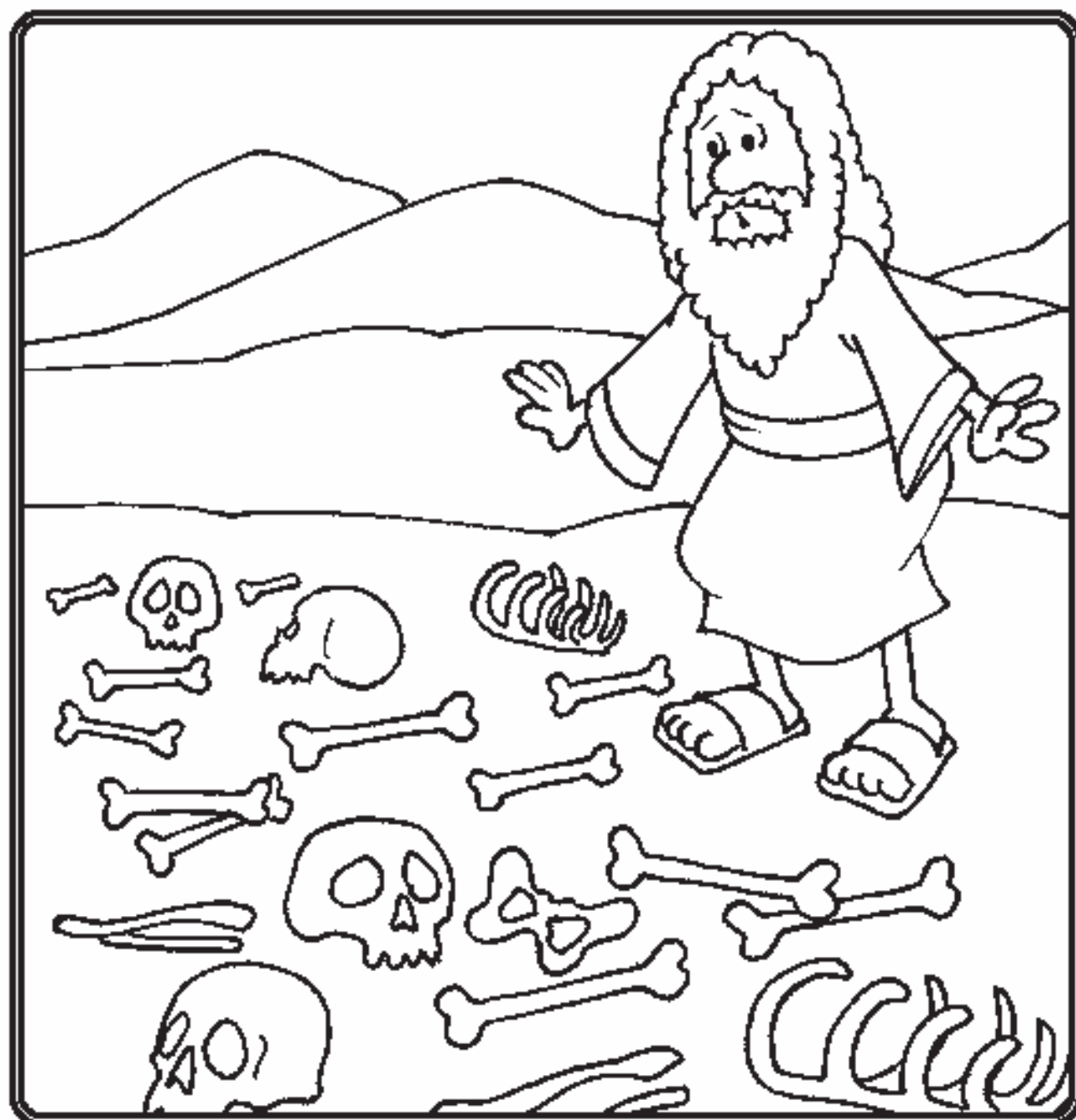
Visit a museum and look at the bones of dinosaurs and other animals that once were alive but are now dead. Talk about what it would have been like to live with dinosaurs!
