## King Jesus Is Alive!

### Lesson Theme: Jesus lives!

---



#### Materials:

- Red heart-shaped balloons
- Party helium tank or your own air
- Red strings



#### Bible Character: Mary



#### Bible Verse

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God All-Powerful. He was, he is, and he is coming." Revelation 4:8 ICB



#### Bible Story

*My First Study Bible*, pp. 419–27, "Jesus Is Alive"

#### Story Application:

- Jesus is alive! Jesus died on the cross and is now alive in heaven with God!
- Do you remember last week when we painted our hearts red? Our sin colored our hearts white, but the blood of Jesus washed them clean again.
- When Jesus rose from the dead, He also gave us another special gift: the gift of the Holy Spirit.



#### Craft

When Jesus rose from the dead, He "breathed" on the disciples, and the Holy Spirit filled their hearts. When you pray for Jesus to forgive your sins, the Holy Spirit comes in, fills your heart, and helps you to follow Jesus.

Pray with each child:

"Dear Jesus, I am sorry I am a sinner and I am not perfect. Jesus, You were perfect and You died for me. Thank You for Your blood that washes my sins away. I love You, Jesus, and I want to be with You and God in heaven one day. Please send the Holy Spirit to fill my heart."

Explain to the children that we cannot see the Holy Spirit. If we could, it might look like this: Place red heart balloon on helium tank and inflate balloon. Fill one balloon for each child to take home as a reminder of the Holy Spirit, who wants to dwell in their hearts.



#### Closing Prayer

Dear God, thank You for the gift of the Holy Spirit.

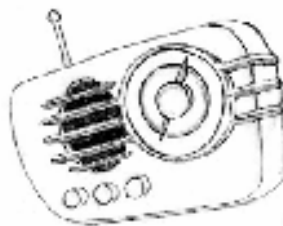
### This week try these fun activities with your child:

Listen to a Christian radio station and talk about how many times God is called "Holy" in the songs you hear.



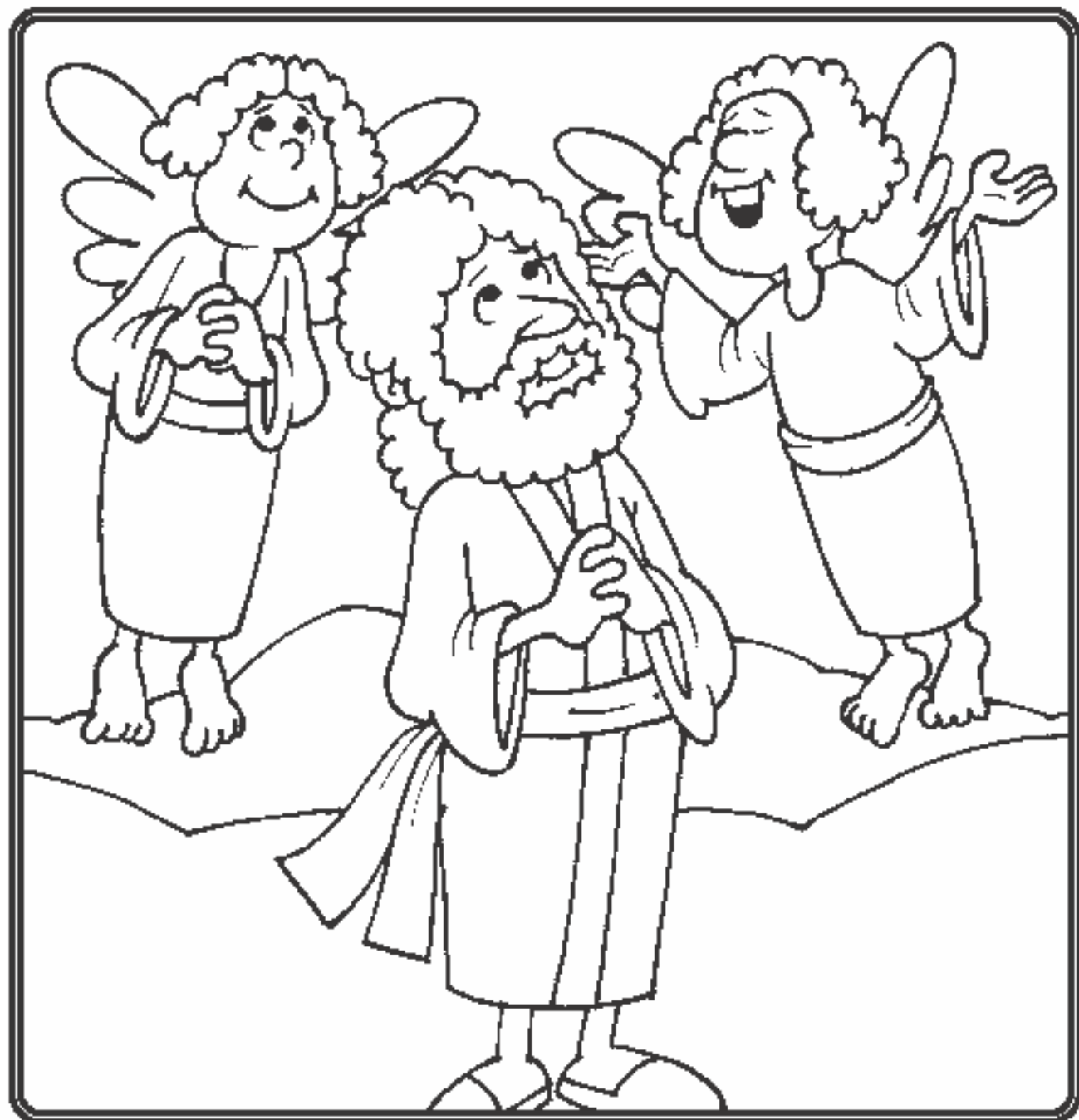
