#### Story Application:

- Job trusted God to take care of him. Even when Job lost all he had, he still loved God and trusted God to take care of him.
  - What is your favorite toy? Do you love God more than that toy? If you lost your toy, would you still love God? That was how Job felt. He was sad he lost everything, but that did not change his love for God.
  - God loves you even more than you love Him! Even though we can't see God, we must trust Him and love Him more than the things we can see.

#### Craft

Have the children name items that are important to them that they "love." (dolls, trucks, toys, etc.) Then read the activity sheet to them: "Jesus, I love You more than my favorite \_\_\_\_\_. When they are finished, go around the table and have children share what they drew.
