### Bible Story

*My First Study Bible*, pp. 412–18, "Jesus Is Crucified"

#### Story Application:

- Jesus is God, and He is perfect. He never disobeyed His parents or told a lie.
  - The only way to be with God in heaven when we die is to be perfect. But we are not perfect. We sin. Because we sin, we cannot live with God.
  - Jesus is perfect. When He died, His blood covered our sins so that we could one day be with Him in heaven. When you pray for Jesus' blood to cover your sins, then God does not see your sins. He sees Jesus, and He accepts you just as He accepts His Son, Jesus.

### Craft

Have children cut out the red hearts. Pass out the white chalk.

Explain that when we use bad words, disobey our parents, lie, hurt others, etc., we sin against God. That sin hurts our hearts, and we are no longer perfect. Have children draw on hearts.

Jesus' blood washes away our sins and makes our hearts pure again so we can be with God. But for Jesus' blood to wash our hearts clean, we need to agree that we have sinned, pray to Him, and ask Him to come and clean us. We can pray a prayer like this:

"Dear Jesus, I am sorry I am a sinner and I am not perfect. Jesus, You were perfect and You died for me. Please use Your blood to wash my sins away. I love You, Jesus, and I want to be with You and God in heaven one day."

Brush red paint on children's hearts to "wash away" their sins.

Dear Parent,

Today your child heard the story of Jesus' death on the cross. We learned that Jesus is God and He is perfect. The only way to be with God in heaven when we die is to be perfect. But we are not perfect. We sin. Because we sin, we cannot live with God.
