Bible Verse

Bible Story

My First Study Bible, pp. 87–92, "I Chose God's Side"

Story Application:

- Rahab hid the spies under stalks on top of her roof. God allowed the spies to be hidden to save their lives. Later, God allowed Rahab and her family to be hidden to save their lives.
- Today we "hide" the Word of God in our hearts. It is there to help us make good choices for God. We can't see the Bible in our hearts, but we know it is there when we can remember the Bible verses we are learning.
- Make the recipe below for a tasty reminder of how God hid the spies.



Snack

- Open the package of crescent rolls and unroll them.
- In each triangle place a small hot dog.
- "Hide" the hot dog in the dough and place each on a cookie sheet.
- Cook the rolls as directed on the package.
- Enjoy your hidden-surprise treat!

While you are waiting for the snack to cook, have the children color the Rahab craft page to remind them how God hid the spies.
