Is there some way you know God has placed your family in this city and at this church? Talk to your children about how you feel God is using your family.



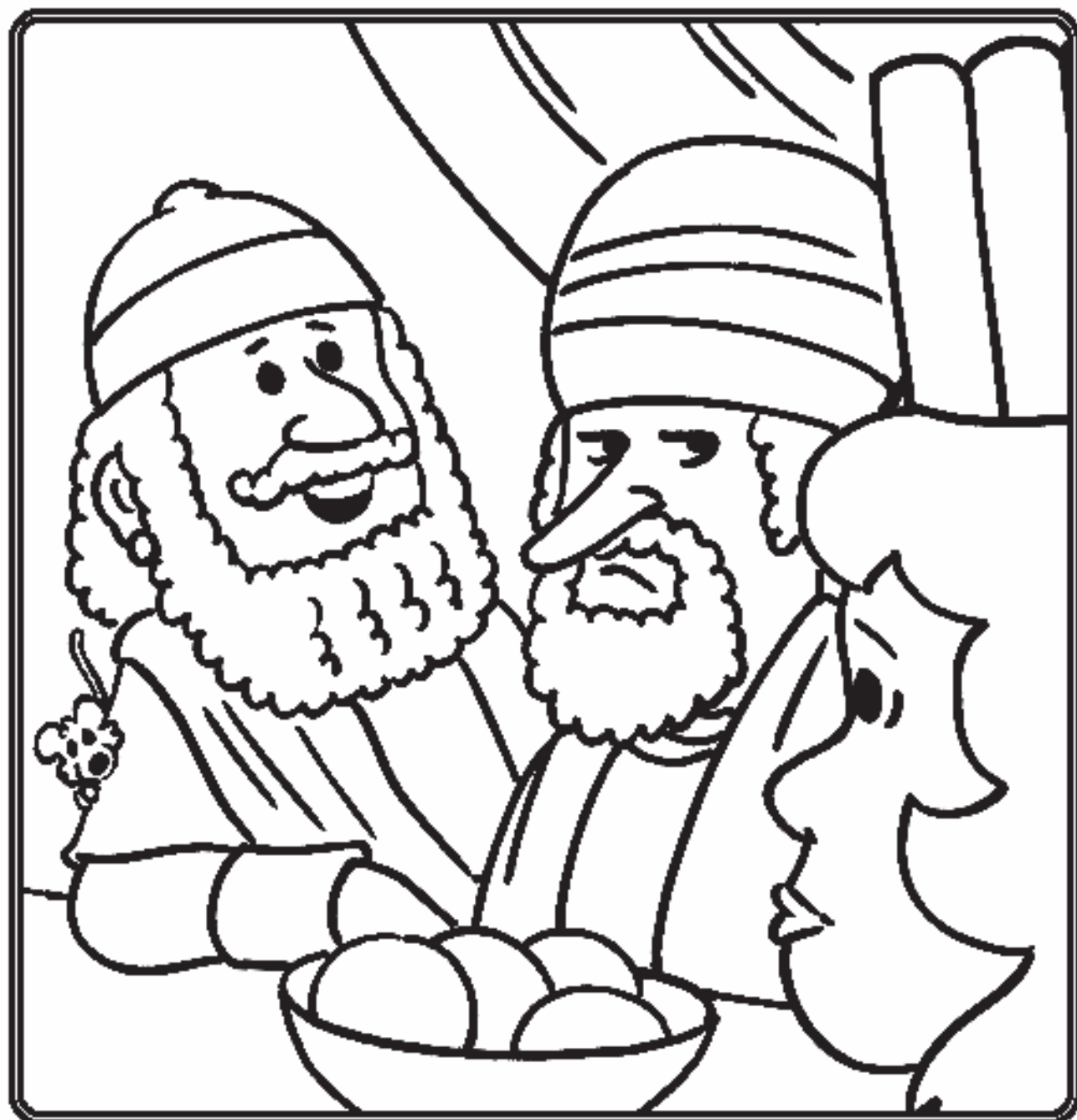
