## Bible Story

### Story Application:

- Last week we talked about how we can obey Jesus by focusing our eyes on Him. This week we are learning that even nature listens to Jesus!
  - Jesus told the wind to stop, and it did! Jesus is VERY powerful! We can trust Jesus to take care of us.
  - Who are the strongest people you know? Jesus is stronger! What are the hardest things for you to do? Jesus is strong enough to do all those things!

## Craft

Give each child a handful-size blob of shaving cream at his or her spot on the table. Have the children make waves with caps on the lake with their hands. Then have them pretend to be Jesus and make the waves go flat with their hands. Note: Shaving cream washes off quickly and will clean the tables in the process.
